Fund Descriptions

Mission Support Funds the general operating budget of the synod, contributes 42% to the income of ELCA Churchwide. Includes staff salaries and benefits, operating expenses, and the ongoing gospel work of congregations, campus ministries and key social institutions in the synod. Enables the staff and volunteers of the Bishop's Office to walk with Lutherans and others everywhere into increased faithfulness, courage and capacity for grace-filled ministry in communities across the state.

Courageous Love Fund nurtures innovation and vitality within the synod - in existing congregations, mission starts, and other ventures of faith.

Biblical and Theological Engagement activates faithful inquiry into Christian discipleship through continuing education programs for all people interested in developing their knowledge of Holy Scripture, religious history, spiritual practices, interfaith relations and more.

Racial Repair and Relationship Fund works to build capacity for the necessary work of relationship, reconciliation and repair with our neighbors who are Black, Indigenous or Persons of Color.

ELCA World Hunger: committed to sustainable solutions to end hunger in the United States and beyond.

Lutheran World Relief: focuses on sustainable development projects and disaster relief and recovery.

Oregon Synod Endowment Fund for Leaders (Allert Fund): funds seminary education for Oregon candidates throughout the Oregon Synod.

Camp Lutherwood, Oregon: Offers an outdoor experience that empowers staff and guests of all ages to discover caring and affirming relationships with God, others and the natural world.

Campus Ministries in Oregon (OSU's Luther House and UofO's Good Soil): Supports the spiritual, ethical, personal and theological formation of young adults in college and beyond.
